News, on global warming, predicts that the Arctic Ocean will soon disappear.

For millions of years, the sea around the North Pole has been frozen all year round but now things are changing fast.

Experts say that in a decade the Arctic Ocean will probably be like a normal sea and this will have consequences for the whole world's weather.

All kinds of disasters and extreme weather events will happen as the world will become a lot warmer. These include massive flooding –so many of the coastal cities will disappear–, much more dangerous hurricanes will take place –so many poor countries will suffer the destruction of their houses–, and deserts will become bigger and bigger in our world.

Many people, around the world, are asking politicians and world leaders to act urgently in reducing their carbon emissions by 40 per cent by 2020.
