LA. HIT BY QUAKE

Early this morning, Los Angeles was hit by the city's worst earthquake for 150 years. At least 24 people were killed when buildings collapsed. Thousands of people were injured (1) as houses and apartment blocks were wrecked by the quake. The earthquake was recorded at the California Institute of Technology in Pasadena. It was felt in Las Vegas over 275 miles away.

The centre of the earthquake was in S. Francisco Valley in the north of the city near Hollywood. In Hollywood and Beverly Hills over 50 buildings were destroyed. The homes of some famous film stars were badly shaken. Streets were covered with glass as windows were smashed (2) by the quake. In the suburb (3) of Northridge the groundfloor of a building collapsed and 18 people are trapped.

Many buildings have been burnt down. Fires started when gas pipes were broken. There were huge fires on both sides of the Golden Gate Freeway. Water pipes were also broken and roads, streets and buildings are now flooded (4). The famous Los Angeles freeways were bent and twisted by the earthquake. A police motorcyclist was killed when part of the Santa Monica Freeway collapsed (5) under him. The airports and the railways have been closed.

Today the people of Los Angeles are trying to get back to normal life, but it won't be easy. Many people's homes have been destroyed and thousands of buildings have no water, gas, telephones or electricity. Over 250 people have been taken to Sylmar hospital, but the building has no power. The services won't be fully restored for weeks. The freeways will be repaired quickly. LA is the city of the car and without the freeways the smaller roads will be blocked by thousands of vehicles.

But these things aren't the biggest problem in the city today. A lot of earthquakes happen in California and a big earthquake was expected. The question in Los Angeles today is, was this the Big One, and if not, when will it happen?


