He was born on September 13, 1916 in Wales to Norwegian parents. He died in 1990.

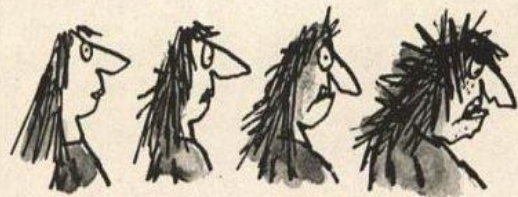
September is Roald Dahl's birth month, and each year people all over the world celebrate with a wonderful array of events centred around his birthday on 13th September.

In 2016 we marked 100 years since the birth of Roald Dahl with the biggest worldwide celebration of Roald Dahl Day ever!

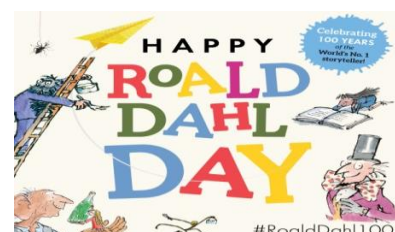
